Council Minutes - May 2, 2023

Members Present: Dave Anderson, Marnie Anderson, Steve Lamberson, Kay Nelson, Barb Mathson, Ellen Hauser, Clarice Laehn and Lori Paulson. Dave Anderson, council president called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Preparation:

- 1. Opening Devotions: Council members shared something positive that they experienced
- 2. Prayer Requests/Homebound: John Mathson, Family of Irene Franson
- 3. Communication from Congregation: None

Communication/Action:

- 1. Secretary's Report: Kay Nelson made a motion to approve April 2023 minutes with a second by Steve Lamberson. Motion carried.
- 2. **Treasurer's Report**: Steve Lamberson reported the following fund balances as of April 2023: General Fund: \$33,346; On Going: \$12,129; Improvement: \$34,261. Steve Lamberson made a motion to approve the treasurer's report with a second by Barb Mathson. Motion carried.

3. Ministry Teams Updates:

- a) <u>Life & Growth:</u> Life & Growth are sponsoring a diaper drive in April and May; quilts were given to Pastor Jonas and Sherry Pabst.
- b) <u>WELCA</u>: WELCA will meet on Thursday, May 4th at Our Saviour's; \$100 has been donated to quilters.
- c) <u>Men's Brotherhood</u>: Cub Scouts are doing pretty well. There has been an uptick in interest, both boys and girls.
- d) <u>Worship & Music</u>: April Noisy Offering of \$430 was donated to WELCA for mission kits; Noisy Offer ing for May and June will go to Relay for Life. New Horizons sent a thank you note for donation fro March Noisy Offering. The benefit concert at Blair Lutheran Church raised almost \$2,000 for the food pantry.
- e) <u>Property & Finance</u>: Circuit breakers went out due to the sump pump burning out.

Celebration/Affirmation:

- a) The next council meeting is scheduled for June 6, 2023, at 6:30 p.m.
- b) Discussion held regarding pay for supply preachers.
- c) Motion made by Barb Mathson and seconded by Clarice Laehn to no longer include hymn lyrics and readings in the bulletin and power point. Motion carried with understanding that the responsorial psalms would remain in both the bulletin and power point.

Business Items:

- a) Discussion held regarding office secretary position.
- b) Issuance of gas cards, emergency food and diapers, etc. will need to be put on hold for the time being.
- c) Church website will cost \$504 for two years and must be paid by credit card only. WELCA credit card may be used to pay for the cost with reimbursement from General Fund.
- d) Need someone to maintain the church's website and Facebook page.

Kay Nelson made a motion to adjourn with a second by Marnie Anderson. Motion carried.


