Dear friends,

Several good things have been happening in connection to RUTH, our developing faith-based community organizing partnership. In this month's newsletter, I would like to catch you up on recent developments.

First, new leadership has stepped forward to continue the fine work of Sleep in Heavenly Peace. You may remember that Sleep in Heavenly Peace is a volunteer movement which builds simple beds and provides bedding for children. Pastor Dave Christianson, (Trinity Parish, South Beef River and King's Valley Lutheran Churches, with Upper Pigeon Creek Parish) along with Tom Twesme of Osseo will be the new Co-Presidents for the group. This means that our local SHP chapter in Trempealeau County, which has built 100's of beds can continue this important ministry. Pr.David and Tom will attend the National Training on October 13-14, 2022, in Utah. Current volunteers from the established teams have let them know they will continue with their service. We hope to add Buffalo County to our local SHP chapter and volunteers from Mondovi are willing to serve.

Second, Deacon Lidixe Montoya, Director of Neighbors to Neighbors, a Hispanic outreach ministry of our Northwest Synod of the ELCA invited RUTH to co-sponsor and organize a Health Fair in the Trempealeau County area specifically for the Latino population of the region. Several willing volunteers felt this was a great project for RUTH and formed a taskforce to begin planning. Pastor Paola and Romena Vasquez who serve United Methodist Churches in Pepin and Whitehall are participating in the task force, along with Deacon Montoya, Tekla Baken, Deb Pattee, Scott Brown, Maddie Leske and me. more details come together. 


