

Pastor Greg Ofsdahl



Dear People of God at Our Saviour's in Whitehall,

To introduce myself, I am Greg Ofsdahl. I serve as pastor at Peace Lutheran of Pigeon Falls and for a short time, I will also be serving as your administrative interim. I grew up in Ettrick and am thrilled to be doing what I love back in my home area! Until the synod office identifies a full-time interim pastor for your congregation, I will be helping to schedule pulpit supply preachers, assisting with church council guidance, and providing hospital, homebound and other essential visitation. Please feel free to contact me when you know of someone wishing to have a visit. I would be glad to bring communion.

Interim periods can be trying for congregations. Anxiety can overwhelm as we look to the future and wonder what is happening?... what will happen?... will we be ok?

Let me share this story:

A carpenter had been in his shop building some crates for the clothes his church was sending to an orphanage in China. On his way home, he reached into his shirt pocket to find his glasses, but they were gone. When he replayed in his mind what he had been doing, he realized what had happened; the glasses must have slipped out of his pocket into one of the crates, which was now on its way to China! The Great Depression was at its height, and the carpenter had six children at home. He had spent \$20 for those glasses earlier that very day. He was quite distraught over the thought of having to buy another pair. Several months later, the director of the orphanage was visiting the United States and planned to stop at all the churches that had supported the orphanage in China. He came to speak one Sunday at the carpenter's church. The director began by thanking the people for their faithfulness and support. "But most of all," he said, "I must thank you for the glasses you sent last year. The communists had just swept through the orphanage, destroying everything, including my glasses. I was desperate. Then your crates arrived. When my staff removed the covers, they found a pair of glasses lying on top. When I tried them on, it was as though they had been custom-made just for me! I want to thank you for being part of that." The people listened, happy for the miraculous glasses story, but thought the director surely must have confused the crates they sent with those of another church as they had not sent any glasses! But sitting quietly in the back with tears streaming down his face, the carpenter realized that the Master Carpenter had used him in an extraordinary way.

What often feels like uncertainty for us can, in the end, be times of learning, growth and new opportunities. Pray, encourage one another, step out in new ways to serve. During this interim period, and forever, remember that Christ is the head of the Church and will always be our solid rock. God is always active and up to something. We have faith that this remains true at Our Saviour's Church too. Hang on...stick together!
