

Hello All.

John 6:27-29 27Jesus said, "Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For it is on him that God the Father has set his seal." 28Then they said to him, "What must we do to perform the works of God?" 29Jesus answered them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in him whom he has sent." (I think he should be He).

The last Sunday of July and all of August we will be reading from the Gospel of John. Food is discussed a lot, beginning with the feeding of the 5,000 with two fish and five barley loaves of bread, and leading into Jesus is the bread of life, all of which is in the 6th chapter.

Our physical body will die without food to nourish it. Our spiritual body will die without the God to nourish our spirit. Jesus' followers saw and experienced many "signs" (John's term for what we believe are miracles) that Jesus performed. As God, Jesus was able to perform these signs, easily. Because He was making things happen as God, they were not truly "miracles", they were signs of what the human Jesus was able to accomplish through God. The signs were done so we humans can know Jesus is God.

I heard recently that the President of one of the Seminaries, would not allow the student Pastors to use the word "miracle". He truly felt God does not do miracles, He does what is needed for that time and moment, and because God is God, it works. The human me, still likes the word "miracle" and want to see lots of them. To me creation is a miracle. Humans, animals, birds, fish, plants, all things living and non-living things are miracles that were created together to make the earth a wonderful place for all of us to live our "earthly" lives. Jesus is preparing us for our "heavenly" lives.

Food and water are essential for all living beings. My heart breaks when I see news articles depicting the horrible conditions in other countries in which there is not enough food or water for the poorest and displaced. Many world organizations are working daily to put some relief into place, however, a lot more needs to be done. I keep hearing that there is enough food on the planet to feed all of us. Apparently some of it is in the wrong places.

The Evangelical Lutheran Church of America and ELC worldwide is one of the organizations helping to get food into places of the greatest need. As Lutherans, in addition to prayer, we can donate from our "plenty" for those with next to nothing. I know not everyone has "plenty" but even a little from many adds up to "plenty" over time. Please consider finding ELCA World Hunger on your computer to find ways to help and possibly donate. The "widows and orphans" of the world need our help.
